SUBJECT: -Extension of General Affiliation up to Senior Secondary Level .

This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. In this connection, I am directed to convey the approval of the Board for Extension of General Affiliation as per details given below:-

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	During review, it has been found that, school is constructing an additional building, in which there are multiple windows opening on the outer side and the said part is itself used as a boundary wall. Thus, the school is directed to ensure that it should be bounded with boundary wall with minimum 6 ft of height from all sides. The school is required to take the necessary action in r/o above and submit the compliance within 03 months.
2	In all of the science labs, plastic chairs are being used for seating. There are curtains observed on the windows in physics lab, which are fire hazard and side slabs are constructed adjacent to wall in the biology lab, which are not appropriate for conducting practical. Thus, the school is directed to not to use the side slabs for practical (biology lab) , remove the curtain from the window (physics lab) and replace the plastic chairs with wooden stools in all of the science lab within 03 months and submit the compliance
3	The composite science lab is temporarily arranged, which is a makeshift arrangement. There are no permanent fixtures, washbasins, water and gas connection in the workstation, proper storage facilities, sufficient seating arrangement (wooden stools) and safety features such as fire extinguishers and exhaust fan. Thus, the school is required to upgrade the said lab as per above and Board's SoP within 03 months and submit the compliance
4	The school has converted regular cubicles into CWSN toilets, but they are very narrow and there is no room for a wheelchair/walker to navigate. Further, there are steps at the entrance of CwSN toilets, which are not suitable for CwSN . Thus, the school is required to ensure that entrance of the CwSN toilets should be barrier free and reconstruct the CwSN toilets separately for boys and girls on each floor with sufficient space for easy movement of the wheelchair and proper permanent signage (on the cubicle indicating the floor number) as per norms of RPwD Act and board's guidelines within 3 months and submit the compliance.
5	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Prayagraj within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

1. The approval is based upon the documents /data/information uploaded by the school online. The school will be responsible for its genuineness. In case of any discrepancies, necessary action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School is required to apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school should go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy there of for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school is required to renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of

these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.

7. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
8. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

“The school shall possess valid fire safety certificate and Building safety certificate during functioning of the school which shall be renewed from time to time as per norms”.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months, the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
